**CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #1: Queens Quay Revitalization
Stage One: Utility Upgrades and TTC Rebuild**

The following advance utility work is scheduled for the week of June 4th, to June 8th, 2012

BELL

- **Construction Activity:**
All utility locates have been completed for Queens Quay. This now allows Aecon Utilities, under contract to Bell, to begin their work on Wednesday June 6th. Aecon's work will focus on York Street, between Harbour and Queens Quay. They will be spotting, and saw cutting in preparation for the directional bore. The focus of their work activities will be in this area for the remainder of the week. A drill machine will be located adjacent to the York Street off-ramp park area. Drilling activities will be approximately 1.2 metres in depth at the corner of Queens Quay and York St.
 - **What to Expect:**
The single north bound lane of traffic onto York St. from Queens Quay will be affected this week. Paid duty officers will help divert traffic as required during this period. When crews are working on sidewalk areas, they will cordon off a 100 metre-stretch of the outside westbound traffic lanes. Intermittent noise should be expected between the hours of 8am to 5pm, each day.
 - **Pedestrian Access:**
Fast fence will be erected by Aecon crews around their work areas, but pedestrian access will be maintained. Paid duty police officers will also be on site directing vehicle and pedestrian traffic.
- Upcoming Work:
- Crews will continue to work on Queens Quay starting the week of June 11th, and for the next two to three weeks. These crews will begin work at York St. and continue west on Queens Quay. The majority of this work will be located on the sidewalk areas of Queens Quay.
