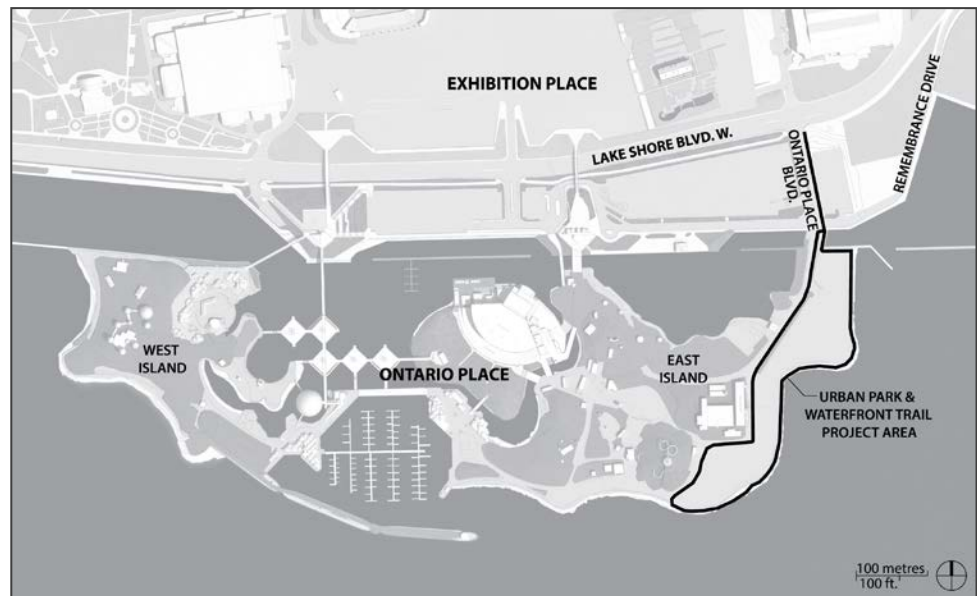


**NOTICE OF CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND PUBLIC MEETING / OPEN HOUSE
PROPOSED URBAN PARK AND WATERFRONT TRAIL AT ONTARIO PLACE
MINISTRY OF INFRASTRUCTURE PUBLIC WORK CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT**

Infrastructure Ontario, on behalf of the Ministry of Infrastructure, and in partnership with the Ministry of Tourism, Culture and Sport is conducting a Category B Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) under the Ministry of Infrastructure Public Work Class Environmental Assessment (MOI PW Class EA) for a proposed urban park and waterfront trail at Ontario Place.

Ontario Place is located at 955 Lake Shore Boulevard West in Toronto, Ontario. The proposed urban park and waterfront trail is estimated at 7.5 acres and will be located along the east side of the Ontario Place East Island (see Map). The proposed park may also include a small area of land currently under the administration and control of the Federal Government and a small parcel of land currently under the administration and control of the Municipal Government.

The new waterfront trail will connect to the existing Martin-Goodman Trail/Trans Canada Trail Ontario that is situated alongside Lake Shore Boulevard. It is the Government of Ontario's goal that the proposed urban park and waterfront trail be ready for use in 2015, in time for the 2015 Pan/Parapan American Games.

The urban park and waterfront trail at Ontario Place will be located along a portion of the East Island previously used as a parking lot. The main activities for the project are design services, contaminant search, construction, landscaping, and grounds maintenance, leasing and/or licensing agreement (e.g., for use of municipal property), and transfer of administration and control of land from the federal government to the provincial government.

A Public Meeting & Open House is being held to give the public an opportunity to learn more about the proposed urban park and waterfront trail and the MOI PW Class EA process being followed. The Public Open House is scheduled as follows:
