## **CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #20: Martin Goodman Trail Connection June 24, 2013 to June 28, 2013**

Eastern Construction's sub-contractor – Coco Paving – has completed the concrete sidewalk between Lower Jarvis Streets to the Pier27 Presentation Centre (east of Lower Yonge St). This section is now open to the public. Construction of the remaining short section of curb, sidewalk, and MGT bike lanes from the Pier 27 Presentation Centre to the west side of Lower Yonge Street began on June 14 after utility crews working on another project vacated the area. Once our construction activities are complete, the Martin Goodman Trail will officially open.

The infrastructure work for the new signalized intersection at Lower Sherbourne and Queens Quay East has been completed. Final works are underway to provide power to the signal which is expected to be operational next week.

Crews have completed the installation of granite pavers along the head of the Jarvis Slip. The reinstatement of the guardrail, installation of new light poles and asphalt paving has also been completed and opened to the public.

### *Pedestrian and Vehicle Access:*

Two-way traffic will be maintained along Queens Quay, but some short term lane diversions may be required when crews are completing curbs, sidewalks, lane painting, and final detail landscape work. Traffic barrels will be used to mark these localized work areas and their progress along Queens Quay.

All driveways will be maintained during construction. Pedestrian access will be maintained on the northside of Queens Quay with alternative diversion paths marked with signage.

### **LOOK AHEAD: UPCOMING WORK**

- Permanent line markings and custom buffer work to be completed
- A short section of new sidewalks and MGT bike trail to be completed at the Yonge St. slip.
