SPECIAL QUEENS QUAY CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Partial Closure of Eastbound Spadina/ Lake Shore Intersection

The eastbound Lake Shore Boulevard intersection at Lower Spadina Avenue will be partially closed for the streetcar track construction at the [Spadina Loop](#) during the following dates and times:

Stage 1 – Beginning **Friday, November 1st**, at **7:00 pm** until **Monday, November 4th**, at **6:00 am**; and
Stage 2 – Beginning **Friday, November 8th**, at **8:00 pm** until **Tuesday, November 12th**, at **6:00 am**

Traffic travelling eastbound on Lake Shore Boulevard will be reduced to one lane at the Lower Spadina Avenue intersection. The Spadina off-ramp from the eastbound Gardiner will also be reduced to one lane during these times. Overnight work should be expected during the weekend closures. Electronic message boards will be located throughout the surrounding area to inform drivers of the lane reductions.

Westbound traffic on Lake Shore Boulevard will not be impacted.

Southbound traffic on Spadina Avenue wishing to turn left onto eastbound Lake Shore Boulevard will be limited to passenger vehicles only. Trucks and buses will be directed to divert via Bremner Avenue to Rees Street, Lower Simcoe Street or York Street, where they can turn south and re-join eastbound traffic on Lake Shore Boulevard. Two additional electronic message boards will be positioned on Spadina Avenue - one at King Street and one at Front Street - to inform drivers and vehicles of this detour.

The 510 Spadina TTC bus will not be impacted as it has already been using this route for the past few months.

Paid duty police officers will be on site at all times throughout both weekends to help divert traffic during these construction activities.
