**CONSTRUCTION UPDATE #6: Queens Quay Revitalization
Stage One**

No construction activities are scheduled for the week of July 9 to July 13, 2012.

BELL

Construction Activity:

Aecon (Bell's construction contractor) completed their civil work on Friday, July 6. No construction activities are scheduled for the coming week. Bell will begin to plan and schedule its cabling operations for the newly installed infrastructure.

What to Expect:

Aecon crews de-mobilized from Queens Quay on July 6. Road and sidewalk surfaces have been restored to their original conditions.

Pedestrian and Vehicle Access:

There are no restrictions to pedestrian or vehicular access.

Upcoming Work:

For the week of July 16, Bell is expected to continue developing its cabling schedule. Once the schedule is complete, further communication will be provided.

HYDRO

Hydro is in the process of obtaining permits for its work. When the necessary permits are in place, Hydro's first construction-related activity will be to mark "locates" on Queens Quay using spray paint that fades over time. Provincial law requires that gas, electrical and other services in and near an area to be excavated are accurately located and marked prior to excavation.
