Key Message	<p>A community consultation and engagement plan is being developed in collaboration with Sidewalk Labs. The plan is based upon the feedback from the public resulting from the November 2017 town hall, through social media and the themes emerging in the media coverage since the announcement of the partner selection. It is also being informed by early outreach to community advocates, recognized experts and government stakeholders.</p> <p>The proposed process is also based on Waterfront Toronto's historically successful engagement process as well innovative elements based on recent research for our Engagement Plus strategy have been incorporated into this process.</p> <p>The Engagement Plus strategy will be presented to the Board this quarter.</p>
Areas of note/ Key issues	Items to be discussed include the proposed principles that will guide our approach to engagement, high-level topics to be explored and the spectrum of engagement activities being considered.
Expected Outcome	Inform Quayside Committee on the process and receive feedback.
Key Takeaways/ Next Steps	Waterfront Toronto and Sidewalk Labs will finalize the consultation and engagement plan for circulation to the Quayside Committee at its next meeting.
