Re: Cherry Street closure and Lake Shore Boulevard sidewalk closure

Good afternoon –

Further to our discussion on the Cherry Street Closure and Re-routing of the Don Valley Trail at our September CLC meeting, below please find additional details on the scheduled timing and duration. A copy of the Cherry Street closure and trail detour map is attached for reference, distribution and posting.

Construction of the Cherry Street tunnel portion of the West Don Lands stormwater management system requires Cherry Street from Lake Shore Boulevard to north of the rail line to be temporarily closed. The closure is scheduled to begin in mid-October and last for approximately two months.

This work also requires the closure of the sidewalk along the north side of Lake Shore Boulevard East between Cherry Street and Parliament Street. The Don Valley Trail will be re-routed for cyclist and pedestrian safety. Cyclists and pedestrians will be directed to the south side of Lake Shore Boulevard. Please see the enclosed map below for further details.

Multiple signs will be installed throughout the area to advise trail users of the detour and the Cherry Street closure.

Please remind your constituent groups that there is ongoing construction activity in the area, so it is necessary to exercise caution while in the area and/or using the trail. Thank you for your continued patience as we construct this vital infrastructure.
