CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Jarvis Dockwall Reinforcement

Last week, Waterfront Toronto began work on replacing approximately 35 metres of existing dockwall reinforcement located along the east side of the Jarvis Street Slip. This project involves necessary structural work on the Jarvis dockwall that is required prior to the start of construction at an adjacent development block. This development block will be the future home of the Waterfront Innovation Centre and construction is scheduled to commence later this year.

Fast fence has been placed around the work zone at the head of the Jarvis Slip and will remain in place throughout construction. Somerville Construction has mobilized on site and crews will complete all necessary work from a barge located in the water at the Jarvis Slip. Minor pedestrian and vehicle disruptions may occur as machinery is placed within the work zone and fast fence area at the head of the slip periodically. Access to Canada's Sugar Beach and the Martin Goodman Trail will be maintained at all times.

Construction is expected to be completed by August 31, 2018.
