## **CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #1: Martin Goodman Trail Connection & Jarvis Dock Wall Reinforcement**

### **PROJECT SCOPE**

During our Construction Information Session on August 30, we outlined our plans to make pedestrian and cycling improvements along Queens Quay East. With construction about to begin, we will now begin to send regular construction updates.

### **WATERFRONT TORONTO/EASTERN CONSTRUCTION**

The initial tender package for the Jarvis Slip Dockwall reinforcement project has been awarded to Somerville Construction.

Fast fence has been erected around the work zone at the head of the Jarvis Slip dockwall in preparation for construction. Crews will begin to mobilize on site during the week of October 9, in anticipation of construction startup the following week.

#### *Pedestrian and Vehicle Access:*

There will be no pedestrian or traffic vehicle disruptions due to these pre-construction activities.

### **LOOK AHEAD: UPCOMING WORK**

- The construction of the Jarvis Slip and Dockwall is expected to begin.
- Additional tender packages will close and a contractor for the Martin Goodman Trail/sidewalk and bicycle lane project will be selected.
