## **CONSTRUCTION NOTICE #2: Jack Layton Ferry Terminal and Harbour Square Park**

Construction on Phase 1A of the Jack Layton Ferry Terminal and Harbour Square Park project began earlier this fall. The western walkway that leads visitors to Harbour Square Park closed in November and construction is now well underway. The asphalt paving to widen the western walkway is scheduled to take place between December 4-6. Construction may result in an unpleasant or offensive odour during this period.

When construction on the western walkway is completed it will be reopened for public access. At this time, construction activities will shift and the main walkway that runs south from Bay Street to the ferry terminal gates will close. We expect construction on the main walkway to begin in early December. Signs will be placed on site to help visitors navigate their way to the ferry terminal and Harbour Square Park.

During construction, trucks will need to cross the Queens Quay pedestrian promenade and Martin Goodman Trail at Bay Street in order to enter and exit the construction site. During these times, flagmen will be on site to safely direct pedestrians and cyclists.
