

EAST BAYFRONT PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE

Waterfront Toronto would like to invite you to a Public Open House for all East Bayfront related projects. The East Bayfront is the area that is bound by Jarvis Street in the west; Parliament Street in the east; Lake Shore Boulevard in the north and the water's edge in the south.
